# **B. QUOTA PLACES**

B.1. Total quota places for Judo

## B.2. Maximum number of athletes per NOC

Event	Quota per NOC
Mixed Team	1 team (12 athletes)

Each qualified NOC can enter a maximum of one (1) team with at least 6 and maximum of 12 athletes.

## C. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

## C.1. Compliance with the Olympic Charter and other relevant rules

All athletes must respect and comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, including but not limited to Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors) and Rule 43 (World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of Manipulation of Competitions).

Only those athletes who respect and comply with the Olympic Charter, the World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of Manipulation of Competitions, including the conditions of participation established by the EOC and the rules of European Judo Union, may participate in the 2023 European Games.





### C.2. Age requirements

All athletes participating in Judo event in the 2023 European Games must be born in the year 2008 or before.

## C.3. Additional European Judo Union criteria

Since these are official European Championships, all athletes must be in possession of valid IJF ID.

## D. QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

The qualification system allows for the participation of the best athletes through a fair and transparent process within the framework of the Olympic Charter.

#### D.1. Qualification Places

#### D.2. Host NOC Places

The host NOC will automatically qualify one (1) team.

#### D.3. Universality Places

Two (2) Mixed Team Universality Places are made available to the eligible NOCs at the 2023 European Games. These places will be allocated by the EOC in conjunction with the European Judo Union.

## E. CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES

The EOC will inform by email the respective NOCs of their allocated quota places (qualified teams and universality places) by Tuesday, 16<sup>th</sup> May 2023.

By 18<sup>th</sup> May 2023, eligible NOCs must inform, by email, the EOC whether or not they intend to use the allocated quota places and participate at the 2023 European Games.





On 19<sup>th</sup> May 2023, the EOC, in agreement with the EJU, will start the reallocation process of all unused quota places.

## F. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

Any unused quota place (including qualification places, host NOC places and universality places) will be allocated to the next best ranked NOC in the IJF Team WRL 15<sup>th</sup> May 2023. This process will be repeated until all places are allocated, or all European teams in the WRL were offered a place. Allocation of still unused quota places is at discretion of the EOC together with European Judo Union.

## H. OLYMPIC GAMES PARIS 2024 QUALIFICATION

The Mixed Team European Championships event at the 2023 European Games counts towards Olympic qualification Paris 2024, with regard to Team invitation places.

According to the Qualification system for Paris 2024, each of the five continents has one (1) Team Invitation place. Athletes who will receive a Team Invitation place are qualified automatically for both the individual and the team event in the Olympic Games. Rules for finding the applicable nation in each continent:

Eligible are nations which have only five (5) athletes instead of the required six (6) team weight categories qualified. The highest ranked eligible nation in each continent from the World Team Ranking List will get a quota place.
